- * Ability to set up IVs (training is available)
- * Good knowledge of cardiac anatomy
- * Proficient with M-Mode and 2D Echo Doppler
- * Experience in Stress Echo and Contrast Echo an asset
- * Ability to work well independently and in an interdisciplinary team environment
- * Prepare accurate reports for physician interpretation

2. Communication

- * Well-developed interpersonal, critical thinking and problem-solving skills
- * Excellent interpersonal, organizational and time management skills
- * Notify cardiologist of significant findings that may necessitate immediate attention to the patient

3. Patient Care
